

User Fee and Billing

1. Equipment user fees

Hourly user fees are charged to recover the costs associated with operating and maintaining equipment. The monthly cap of \$1000 is the maximum amount that is charged for all equipment access in the cleanroom per month. This cap is applied per user and not per faculty or PI. There is no monthly cap on user fee incurred by industry users. The fee rate is summarized in the below table.

¹Cleanroom Access fee covers use of general tools (including high resolution microscope, wet benches, and other general lab tools) and consumable materials (including mask, gloves, solvents, and nitrogen gas)

²Current available target materials are Al, Cr, Cu, Ti, and Ni. Other target materials except those available materials should be supplied by users.

³For photolithography process, users need to bring their own photoresists and developers. For a case that users want to use photoresists and developers from the cleanroom, additional fee will be charged. (SU-8 photoresist /developer: \$250, AZ photoresist/developer: \$200)

2. Labor fees (\$20/hour)

This fee is charged in addition to the equipment use rate when staff labor is required or desired. Examples include equipment training of new users, and processing or measurement supported by a cleanroom staff member. Cleanroom labor fees are not capped on a monthly basis for any user.

3. Billing

Each month, users will be given a log-in card for each tool use. This will be stored in the entrance of the cleanroom. When they finish their work, they are required to fill out their use of tools in the log-in card. At the end of month, total usage will be calculated and a copy of an invoice with a copy of the log-in card for that period will be sent to the designated PI or the user's supervisor. PI is required to submit a payment request to Micro/Nano Fabrication Lab
